Please note: A line drawing is sufficient; you do not need to render / shade / colour the sketch.

Your work will be assessed on:

- 3-dimensional representation and accuracy
- i. Imagine a cube of dimension 3"x3"x3".

A small cube of 1"x1"x1" is removed from any one corner of this cube. Draw the resulting form.

ii. Imagine a cylinder of 3" diameter and 6" height. The cylinder is cut into 6 circular slices of equal thickness. Draw all the slices, placed in perfect alignment, clearly showing a gap of 1/2" between them.
